The regular monthly meeting of UAW Local 402 Retirees Chapter was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Brother Tom Mertens. There were 264 members present.

The opening prayer was offered by Brother Wakefield Presley. Brother Mertens read the names of the recently deceased members and then led the Membership in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Brother Mertens announced \$ 613.00 was collected from the Food Drive. For every \$1.00 contributed, 4 meals can be provided. Local 402 and Retirees will go together next year for the Food Drive and call it "The Joe Metzger Food Drive".

Brother Mertens shared that the Trust states we will have Silverscript next year, and no premiums will be paid. We will go thru Caremark to fill your prescriptions. New card is effective Jan 01,2012. Deron Blakely recognized for his assistance.

Brother Mertens asked that retirees support Springfield when they are doing their Christmas shopping.

Brother Misocky gave the process for the luncheon today, and lunch will be served at 11:30 a.m.

Brother Chris Blizzard, First Vice President gave plant report. Currently, we have 604 active employees, and 31 temporary employees (they are 402 members). Zero employees on layoff. TSP have 90 members. Current production is 91 trucks per day on one shift. Current order board is 5531. UPS is ordering the heavy duty truck and only want the trucks built in Springfield, Ohio. Everyone wished a Merry Christmas and Happy Holiday.
